RESOLUTION OF SYMPATHY


WHEREAS, it is with deep regret that the members of the Virginia Association of Assessing Officers have learned of the death of Edward E. Haar; and




WHEREAS, he was a faithful member of the Virginia Association of Assessing Officers; and
