New Developments in Richmond Hotels

This onsite program takes place at Richmond's Jefferson Hotel and the future Graduate Hotel, formerly the Doubletree Hotel. The program focuses on historic restoration, renovations and construction at two existing hotels in downtown Richmond. **Jeanita Harris**, Concierge Manager, of the Jefferson Hotel will provide a tour of the public areas of the hotel featuring the development history and original construction of the hotel. Ms. Harris will also discuss the current renovation and upgrade of guestrooms which will result in a reduced room inventory.

Nicole Boughan, Director of Sales of the Graduate Hotel will provide a tour of the former Doubletree Hotel in its gutted condition allowing attendees to view the structural construction of this twentieth century steel frame structure. The tour and discussion will feature guest rooms, public areas and service areas. The tour will include a visit to the roof top pool which provides panoramic views of downtown Richmond and beyond.

Program Coordinator **Brian Gordineer, AAS** will provide discussion on valuation issues and tax credit programs offered by the City of Richmond, Commonwealth of Virginia and the Department of the Interior.
