The building was designed by New York architect John Eberson for the Loew's Corporation and was considered the most modern theater in the South when it opened in 1928. Therese Evans, of Dominion Arts Center will speak about the use of the tax credits, having been responsible for this aspect of the project and Colin Robinson of Gilbane Construction will address the extent of the renovation. Following the lecture presentations Dolly Vogt of Dominion Arts Center/SMG will lead us across North Sixth Street for a behind the scenes tour of the Carpenter Theater.
