WHEREAS, Mr. Charles Frederick Williams departed this life on September 13, 1977; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Williams served faithfully in the years from 1940 to 1942 as Deputy Commissioner of the Revenue. In 1942 he was appointed Commissioner of the Revenue. He resigned the Commissioner's position in early 1943 to join the Navy but was nominated for the post later in the year while still in the Navy and was elected.

WHEREAS, Mr. Williams devoted 36 years of faithful service as Commissioner of the Revenue for Spotsylvania County.

WHEREAS, He was a member of the Virginia Association of Local Constitutional Officers; member of the Virginia Association of Assessing Officers; member of the Virginia Association of Local Executive Constitutional Officers.

WHEREAS, His stature and judgment were such that his advice was sought from all levels of the community and he will be long remembered for his dedicated life to whatever he was involved.
