WHEREAS, Pistol was instrumental in developing and instructing the first Department of Taxation Mapping Seminars and various other courses and seminars where he earned the respect of Assessors and Commissioners of the Revenue for his natural teaching abilities, acquired knowledge of property valuation, Virginia tax laws, and leadership; and

WHEREAS, he served with outstanding dedication the VAAO on various committees and was Chairman of the Arrangements Committee for the 1987 Annual VAAO Conference; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Virginia Association of Assessing Officers, that Elgin K. McMillian be hereby recognized and commended for his service to the Virginia Association of Assessing Officers, and that the regret of the members at his passing, be expressed by adoption of this Resolution, and that a copy here of be forwarded to the family of our deceased friend
