College of William & Mary President's House & Copper Fox
Distillery Tour
November 17, 2016 / 6pm to 9pm**

This session offered a tour of the President's House at the College of William and Mary with a discussion of the home's history & architecture. William and Mary's President's House is the oldest college president's house in the country. The tour also included a brief visit with the President W. Taylor Reveley, III. A William and Mary student also discussed the archaeological findings of a brewery on the College grounds. The second half of the session was a tour of the Copper Fox Distillery in Williamsburg. The distillery owner Rick Wasmund gave a thorough tour of the facility. He reviewed his experience with local officials & community boards as well as codes & compliance. The tour included steps taken in the property's complete transformation from the former iconic Lord Paget Motel property to a fully functioning distillery with all components including a grainary, still, storage, offices and gift shop/restaurant.
