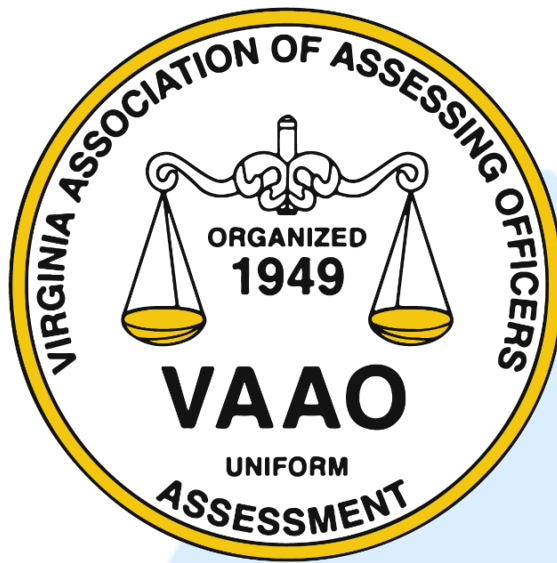

By-Laws Reference: Article II, Section 2: The Education Committee shall be responsible for the planning and execution of the annual Education Seminar. The Education Committee shall be composed of a chairperson(s), an ex-officio(s) and up to twelve other committee members who shall be appointed to three (3) year terms. The three (3) year terms shall be staggered in such a way that the terms of four members shall expire each year, and the president shall appoint up to four new members for three (3) year terms. The IAAO Representative(s), shall be a member of IAAO. The IAAO Representative(s) shall attend and present pertinent information from the IAAO to the VAAO Officers, Directors, committees and membership at VAAO sponsored events. NEED ONE MORE ADDITIONAL MEMBER

By-Laws Reference: Article II, Section 7: The Contracts & Site Review Committee shall be composed of a chairperson and **three (3) other committee members**, who shall be appointed to three (3) year terms. The three (3) year terms shall be staggered in such a way that continuity and knowledge is not disrupted. The president shall also appoint members to fill any unexpired terms which become vacant. The committee shall investigate those sites recommended by the President and Board of Directors for annual conferences and education seminars. The committee may consider two or more years in advance, in order to take advantage of favorable terms for suitable dates and facilities. The committee will provide detailed information, including budget review and recommendations to the President and Board of Directors in time for the board to meet, vote and report its' action to the membership at the annual business meeting. Only the President or his/her assignee may sign a contract on the behalf of the organization.

By-Laws Reference: Article II, Section 9: The Nominating Committee responsibilities and duties are as specified in Article VII of these bylaws. The Nominating Committee shall consist of at least seven members. The immediate past president shall serve as chairperson. The preceding two past presidents shall serve as committee members provided; they are regular or retired members in good standing. Four other regular members in good standing shall be appointed as at-large members by the president. If any of the ex-officio members are not available to serve, the president shall appoint another regular member to the committee. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent any past president from serving as an at-large member of the committee.

Article VII, Section 1: Nominations. The Nominating Committee shall notify the regular membership by VAAO publication or in writing not less than sixty days prior to the annual business meeting of a complete slate of officers and directors subject to election by the membership. Any regular member may submit a written request for the nomination of any regular member for any office or directorship to the nominating committee for its consideration. Such requests for nominations must be received by the Nominating Committee by May or 120 days prior to the annual meeting. All such requests shall be considered by the Nominating Committee prior to the adoption of the slate of nominees required by this Article. The chairperson of the Nominating Committee shall place the previously announced slate of nominees in nomination at the annual business meeting, and the president shall ask for further nominations.
